GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 85-04 2011

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING CERTAIN MOTOR VEHICLES ON RIVER ROAD
BETWEEN COUNTY ROADS 700 WEST AND 800 WEST

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, may adopt ordinances regulating traffic on any highway in the county highway system, subject to I.C. 9-21.


WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, has determined that those motor vehicles, as defined in I.C. 9-13-2-105, having a gross vehicle weight rating of more than four thousand (4,000) pounds should be prohibited from traveling on River Road between County Roads 700 West and 800 West.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

1. Motor vehicles, as defined in I.C. 9-13-2-105, having a gross vehicle weight rating of more than four thousand (4,000) pounds shall be prohibited from traveling on River Road between County Roads 700 West and 800 West.
2. Any person who violates this Ordinance shall be guilty of a Class "C" infraction.
3. The Wabash County Highway Department shall install appropriate signs in accordance with this Ordinance.


