AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE WABASH COUNTY ZONING ORDINANCE

Be it ordained by the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana as follows:

General Ordinance Number 85-2, 2010, adopted March 8, 2010 and entitled An Ordinance Regulating Wind Energy Conservation Systems In Wabash County, Indiana, and being an amendment to the Wabash County Zoning Ordinance, is hereby amended to increase the set-back requirement from 1,500 feet to 2,640 feet as follows:

Section IX-5-C is amended to read:

Except as otherwise provided herein, the setback distance for all COMMERCIAL WECS shall be a minimum of 2,640 feet from any non-applicant Primary Structure.

- 1. No new structure may be constructed with in 800 feet of a WECS turbine tower.
- 2. Provided however, that the Wabash County Plan Commission may waive, but shall not be required to waive, the separation distance between a tower and a structure if it is determined that the structure will not affect the WECS performance.

This amendment shall be in full force and effect upon passage, according to the laws of the State of Indiana.
