GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 2014-85-12

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 94-9, THE COUNTY ROAD SIGN ORDINANCE, PROVIDING FOR STOP SIGNS AT THE INTERSECTION OF COUNTY ROAD 600 EAST AND COUNTY ROAD 900 SOUTH

The Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, may adopt ordinances regulating traffic on any highway in the county highway system, subject to I.C. 9-21.


The Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, has determined that it is in the best interests of the citizens of Wabash County to amend General Ordinance No. 94-9, to provide for motor vehicles traveling east or west on County Road 900 South to stop at County Road 600 East and for motor vehicles traveling north or south on County Road 600 East to stop at County Road 900 South..

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDAINED THAT GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 94-9 IS AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

1. Motor vehicles traveling east or west on County Road 900 South shall be required to stop at County Road 900 South's intersection with County Road 600 East.
2. Motor vehicles traveling north or south on County Road 600 East shall be required to stop at County Road 600 East's intersection with County Road 900 South.
3. The Wabash County Highway Department shall install appropriate signs in accordance with this Ordinance.


