GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 2015-85-02

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 94-9, THE COUNTY ROAD SIGN ORDINANCE, PROVIDING FOR AN ADDITIONAL STOP SIGN AT THE INTERSECTION OF ANGLING ROAD AND COUNTY ROAD 300 NORTH

The Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, may adopt ordinances regulating traffic on any highway in the county highway system, subject to I.C. 9-21.

The Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, has determined that it is in the best interests of the citizens of Wabash County to amend General Ordinance No. 94-9, to provide for motor vehicles traveling south on Angling Road to stop at its intersection with County Road 300 North.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDAINED THAT GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 94-9 IS AMENDED TO ADD THE FOLLOWING:

1. Motor vehicles traveling south on Angling Road shall be required to stop at Angling Road's intersection with County Road 300 North.
2. The Wabash County Highway Department shall install appropriate signs in accordance with this Ordinance.


