GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 2017-85-06

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 2002-85-3

The Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, adopted General Ordinance No. 2002-85-3 prohibiting smoking in certain County owned buildings.

The Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, has determined that it is in the best interests of the citizens of Wabash County to amend General Ordinance No. 2002-85-3 to include additional tobacco related products and devices in its prohibition.


NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

1. Section 1 of General Ordinance No. 2002-85-3 is amended to read as follows:

“Smoking and the use of all tobacco is prohibited, as is possessing, using, distributing, purchasing, or selling of tobacco or nicotine-containing products or devices of any kind or in any form in all buildings owned, leased, occupied, used or operated by Wabash County, Indiana. Such “products” or “devices” shall include, but not be limited to, cigarettes, cigars, snuff, chewing tobacco, e-cigarettes, vaping devices, any type of look-alike products or other related products, devices associated with tobacco and/or nicotine use, or any type of electronic nicotine delivery system.
