## ORDINANCE NO. 2023-85-01

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC ON COUNTY HIGHWAYS (Establishing the speed limit on County Road 700 West south from the town limits of the Town of Roann, Indiana, to County Road 250 South)

The Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, may adopt ordinances regulating traffic on any highway in the county highway system, subject to I.C. 9-21.

The Board of Commissioners has determined that the speed limit on County Road 700 West south from the town limits of the Town of Roann, Indiana, to County Road 250 South should be established at fifty (50) miles per hour.

## NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The speed limit on County Road 700 West south from the town limits of the Town of Roann, Indiana, to County Road 250 South is now established at fifty (50) miles per hour.
- 2. Any person who violates this Ordinance shall be guilty of a Class "C" infraction.
- 3. The Wabash County Highway Department shall install appropriate signage in accordance with this Ordinance.
- 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its publication as required by law.
