ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING COUNTY COMMISSIONER DISTRICTS ORDINANCE NO. 2011-85-05

WHEREAS, the Wabash County Commissioners are required to establish County Commissioner Districts in 2011 pursuant to IC 36-2-2-4; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this ordinance is to establish County Commissioner election districts in Wabash County.

Now therefore be it ORDAINED as follows: Wabash County is divided into three (3) County Commissioner election districts designated numerically as follows:

District 1

This district shall consist of these townships: Chester 1, Chester 2, Chester 3, Chester 4, Chester 5, Chester 6, Pleasant 1, Pleasant 2 and Paw Paw.

District 2

This district shall consist of these townships: Lagro 1, Lagro 2, Lagro 3, Liberty 1, Liberty 2 and Waltz.

District 3

This district shall consist of these townships: Noble 1, Noble 2, Noble 3, Noble 4, Noble 5, Noble 6, Noble 7, Noble 8, Noble 9, Noble 10 and Noble 11.

All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

If any section, provision, or any part of this ordinance is adjudged invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole, or any section, provision, or part thereof not adjudged invalid.
