GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 2013-01

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC ON COUNTY HIGHWAYS (County Road 200 North yield signs)

The Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, may adopt ordinances regulating traffic on any highway in the county highway system, subject to I.C. 9-21.

The Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, has determined that yield signs should be placed on County Road 200 North requiring motor vehicles to yield to school buses exiting the Northfield High School and Sharp Creek Elementary School properties.

To control vehicles traveling east on County Road 200 North, one yield sign shall be placed on the south side of County Road 200 North 1,496.8 feet (0.2835 miles) west of State Road 13.

To control vehicles traveling west on County Road 200 North, one yield sign shall be placed on the north side of County Road 200 North 1,207.0 feet (0.2286 miles) west of State Road 13.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Vehicles traveling east on County Road 200 North shall yield to school buses exiting the Northfield High School and Sharp Creek Elementary School properties 1,496.8 feet (0.2835 miles) west of State Road 13.
- 2. Vehicles traveling west on County Road 200 North shall yield to school buses exiting the Northfield High School and Sharp Creek Elementary School properties 1,207.0 feet (0.2286 miles) west of State Road 13.
 - 3. Any person who violates this Ordinance shall be guilty of a Class "C infraction.
- 4. The Wabash County Highway Department shall install appropriate signage in accordance with this Ordinance.
