ORDINANCE NO. 85-06, 2016

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 85-04, 2010, THE WABASH COUNTY FAIR HOUSING ORDINANCE

In accordance with the Civil Rights Act of 1968, as amended, the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, and Indiana Code 22-9.5, et. seq., the Board of Commissioners adopted a Fair Housing Ordinance to prevent discrimination in the area of housing because of race, color, religion, sex, handicap, familial status or national origin.

The Board of Commissioners finds it to be in the best interests of the citizens of Wabash County, Indiana, to amend Section 2.2 of the Ordinance as provided below:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF WABASH COUNTY, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Section 2.2. of the Wabash County Fair Housing Ordinance is now amended as follows:
 - 2.2. Family, as defined in I.C. 22-9.5-2-9, includes a single individual or person, and a group of individuals or persons residing together, regardless of the actual or perceived sexual orientation, gender identity, or marital state of its members.
- 2. The Auditor of Wabash County is directed to publish this Ordinance as provided by law.
- This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Board of Commissioners on the date shown below.
