GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 2018-85-04

AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE WABASH SUPERIOR COURT ADMINISTRATION OF JUSTICE FUND

As a condition to accepting a plea of guilty to a crime pursuant to a plea bargain in the Wabash Superior Court, offenders agree to pay a sum of up to Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) in a Level 6 or Class D Felony cause, and/or a sum of up to One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) in a Misdemeanor cause to a fund to supplement the Court's operating expenses (the "Administration of Justice Fee").

A specific fund needs to be established to receive such Fee.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. There is now created the Wabash Superior Court Administration of Justice Fund ("Fund").
 - 2. All Administration of Justice Fee revenue shall be deposited in the Fund.
- 3. Money from the Fund may not be deposited or transferred into the County's general fund and does not revert to the County's general fund at the end of a fiscal year.
- 4. Subject to appropriation, the Wabash Superior Court may use any money in the Fund to supplement its operating expenses.
