GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 2019-85-02

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 94-9, THE COUNTY ROAD SIGN ORDINANCE, PROVIDING FOR ADDITIONAL STOP SIGNS AT THE INTERSECTION OF MILL CREEK PIKE, PIKE STREET, AND COUNTY ROAD 300 WEST

The Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, may adopt ordinances regulating traffic on any highway in the county highway system, subject to I.C. 9-21.

The Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, has determined that it is in the best interests of the citizens of Wabash County to amend General Ordinance No. 94-9, to provide for motor vehicles traveling east on Mill Creek Pike and West on Pike Street to stop at their intersection with County Road 300 West.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDAINED THAT GENERAL ORDINANCE NO. 94-9 IS AMENDED TO ADD THE FOLLOWING:

- Motor vehicles traveling east on Mill Creek Pike shall be required to stop at Mill Creek
 Pike's intersection with County Road 300 West.
- Motor vehicles traveling west on Pike Street shall be required to stop at Pike Street's intersection with County Road 300 West.
- 3. The Wabash County Highway Department shall install appropriate signs in accordance with this Ordinance.
