## NOTICE OF PASSAGE OF ADOPTION OF ORDINANCE NO. 2021-85-15 AN ORDINANCE REGULATING SOLAR ENERGY SYSTEMS

Notice is hereby given that on October 12, 2021, the Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, adopted Ordinance No. <u>2021-85-15</u>, an ordinance regulating solar energy systems.

The ordinance establishes regulations for the design, construction, operation, and decommissioning of solar energy systems.

The ordinance provides that any structure or use that violates the ordinance shall be deemed to be a public nuisance, and the owner, lessee, agent, or contractor, as the case may be, shall be liable for maintaining a public nuisance. The ordinance further provides that any person who violates the ordinance or fails to comply with any of its provisions may be fined the sum not less than ten dollars (\$10.00) nor more than three hundred dollars (\$300.00) for each day that such violation or failure continues unabated.
