## A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A POLICY FOR REIMBURSING CELL PHONE EXPENSES TO COUNTY PROSECUTORS

County prosecutors routinely use their personal cell phones to communicate with law enforcement officers, defense attorneys, judges, court staff, and witnesses, in discharging their duties.

The Board of Commissioners believes that since prosecutors are using their personal cell phones for County business, it is appropriate to reimburse them for part of the cost of those phones.

The County Prosecutor's Office recommends that, at the discretion of the County Prosecuting Attorney, he and each prosecutor on his staff be reimbursed the sum of Ninety Dollars (\$90.00) per month out of the Prosecutor's Pre-Trial Diversion Fund, at the discretion of the Wabash County Prosecuting Attorney.

## IT IS THEREFORE NOW RESOLVED:

To help defray the cost of personal cell phone use, at the discretion of the County Prosecutor, he and each prosecutor on his staff may be reimbursed the sum of Ninety Dollars (\$90.00) per month out of the Prosecutor's Pre-Trial Diversion Fund.
