AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC ON COUNTY HIGHWAYS (Establishing the speed limit on East Hanging Rock Road from its intersection with State Road 524 and terminating 5,280 feet east of said intersection)

The Board of Commissioners of Wabash County, Indiana, may adopt ordinances regulating traffic on any highway in the county highway system, subject to I.C. 9-21.

The Board of Commissioners has determined that the speed limit on East Hanging Rock Road from its intersection with State Road 524 and terminating 5,280 feet east of said intersection should be established at thirty-five (35) miles per hour.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The speed limit on East Hanging Rock Road from its intersection with State Road 524, and terminating 5,280 feet east of said intersection shall be thirty-five (35) miles per hour.
- 2. Any person who violates this Ordinance shall be guilty of a Class "C" infraction.
- 3. The Wabash County Highway Department shall install appropriate signage in accordance with this Ordinance.
- 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its publication as required by law.
